

Online Filing of Tax & other Returns

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There are a whole range of Governmental returns that you can now file online: this can save your firm both time and money.

Our E-Business Advisers detail what you can file in this way:

1. What returns can you do online?

There are many Governmental forms and returns you can submit securely over the Internet. These include:

- PAYE (Pay As You Earn)
- Self Assessment
- VAT
- Corporation Tax
- Registering and changing Company Information with Companies House

2. What are the benefits?

Filing returns online has several advantages:

- Online filing is secure
- You can do it when you want to - e.g. at night
- You normally get an immediate confirmation of receipt.
- If you employ less than 50 employees you can get up to **£825 tax-free** from HM Revenue & Customs over a five year period if you file their

End of Year Return (P14s and P35) online early. You will get £250 in the tax year 2005.

- If you are filing your tax returns, automatic calculation of your tax means that you know immediately what you owe or are owed.
- HM Revenue & Customs processes Internet returns faster than paper returns - any money owed to you is repaid sooner, often within a few days.
- Reduction in the amount of paperwork you have to deal with, across all the online filing areas.
- Online help and validation to assure the completeness and accuracy of transactions made, thus reducing the scope for error
- You can get up to seven extra calendar days to pay your VAT when using electronic payment methods.
- You can submit details right up to the closing date

3. How do I use these services?

Firstly, you will need to enrol on the various programmes.

This is a straightforward process, which involves registering for the service, then entering some basic company information in via the web.

You will then have to wait a few days for a PIN number to arrive by post - this provides an

additional level of security for both the Government Department and you.
